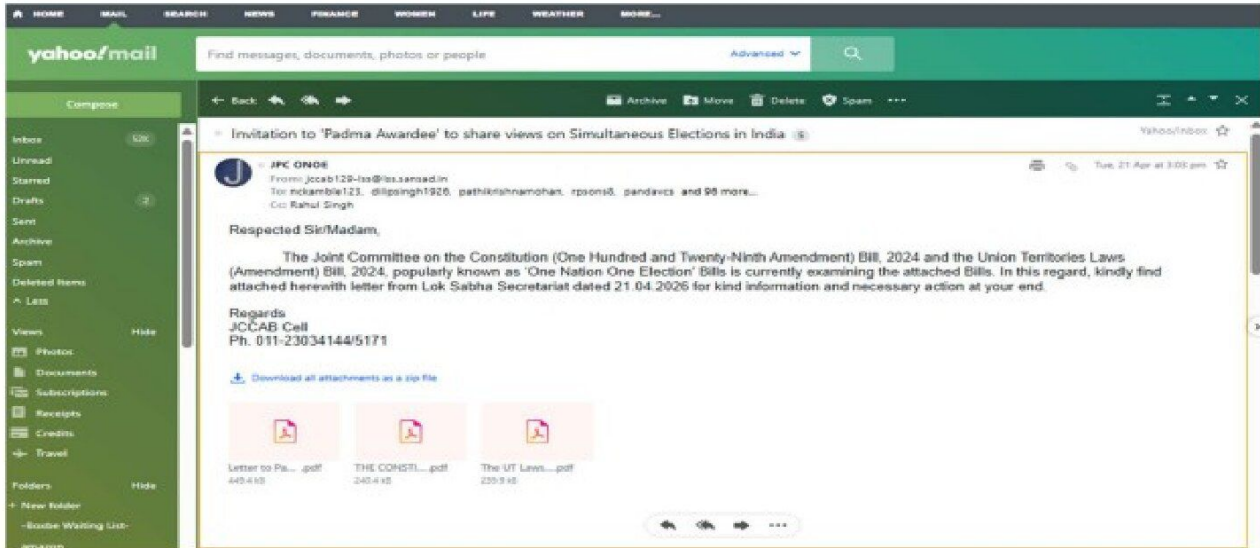

Ref: Regarding my views on simultaneous election in India (Response to your letter No. LAFEAS-JAB029/13/2026-JCCAB, dated: 21.04.2026)

Dear Sir,

I, Dr. Dilip Kumar Singh (100 years old a rural medical practitioner for the last 72 years taking care of poor villagers and tribal, still examining and taking care of ten patients a day) would like to express my sincere gratitude for providing me a chance to share my opinion on the idea of "One Nation, One Election" (simultaneous elections for Lok Sabha and all State Assemblies) has several potential advantages. Here are the key positive points, explained clearly:

#### **1. Reduced Election Expenditure**

Conducting elections together can significantly cut costs for the government, political parties, and administrative machinery. Running separate elections every few months is expensive.

#### **2. Better Governance & Policy Focus**

Frequent elections often lead to imposition of the Model Code of Conduct, which slows down decision-making. With simultaneous elections, governments can focus more on long-term policies rather than short-term political gains.

#### **3. Less Disruption to Public Life**

Elections involve rallies, road shows, security deployment, and administrative diversion. Holding them once in 5 years reduces repeated disruptions in normal life, education, and business.

#### **4. Repeated polarization of society**

During elections, society gets divided on caste, region or communal basis. This causes distress among society. Owing to repeated elections this chaos is sparked again and again. However, one election will minimize the distress eventually.

#### **5. Efficient Use of Resources**

Security forces, Govt. staff, teachers, and administrative staff are repeatedly pulled into election duty. One combined election would free them for their primary roles.

#### **6. Higher Voter Turnout**

When elections are held together, voters may be more motivated to participate, leading to better democratic representation.

#### **7. Reduced Political Polarization**

Frequent elections keep the country in a constant campaign mode, increasing divisive rhetoric. Simultaneous elections may reduce continuous political tension.

#### **8. Stability in Governance**

With fewer election cycles, governments may enjoy more stability and continuity in implementing policies without constant electoral pressure.

#### **9. Financial corruption by political parties**

Repeated election makes unnecessary expenses by political parties on campaigning and rallies. One election will ensure to check the expenses on advertisement/ campaigns by political parties involved.
